Punctuality

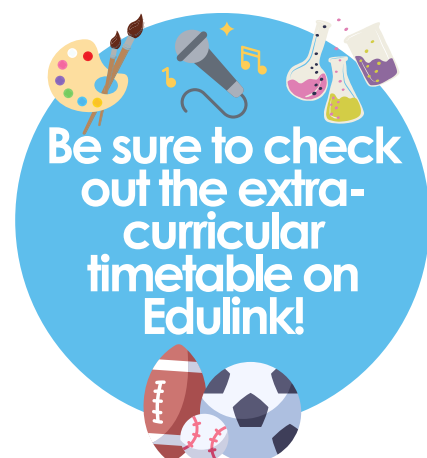
Pouch
