Students will:

- Attend school, all lessons including PDL, be punctual, wear the correct uniform and come properly equipped including phone pouch
- Follow the students' code of conduct - Be Ready, Be Respectful, Be Safe
- Follow Cranbourne's lesson expectations
- Follow Cranbourne policies on anti-bullying
- Complete all homework set on the online platforms
- Make sure that they have their toolkit to support learning
- Always work to the best of their ability
- Take opportunities to enrich the learning experience, e.g. Taking part in clubs, trips and student leadership
- Show mutual respect

Parents/Carers will:

- Contact the school with any concerns or problems

- Ensure that their child attends school and lessons on time, is properly equipped including phone pouch and is correctly dressed
- Attend parent evenings/monitor day to discuss their child's progress
- Regularly check EduLink and support their child's learning journey
- Support the school's policies and procedures, including the Behaviour Policy
- Check that homework is done to the best of their ability
- Support Cranbourne's commitment to mutual respect

As a student using ICT at Cranbourne I agree that:

- I will only use ICT systems in school, including the internet, email, digital video, mobile technologies, etc, for school purposes.
- I will not download or install software on school technologies.
- I will only log on to the school network/ learning platform with my own user name and password.
- I will follow the school's ICT security system and not reveal my passwords to anyone and change them regularly.
- I will make sure that all ICT communications with students, teachers or others is responsible and sensible.
- I will treat the school's equipment that I am given permission to use with respect, and
- I will report issues to the teacher immediately.
- I will be responsible for my behaviour when using the Internet. This includes resources I access and the language I use.
- I will not deliberately browse, download, upload or forward material that could be considered offensive or illegal. If I accidentally come across any such material, I will report it immediately to my teacher.
- I will not give out any personal information such as name, phone number or address using the school system. I will never arrange to meet someone I contacted via the internet.
- Images of students and/ or staff will not be taken, unless for a specific purpose where prior consent is obtained.
- I will ensure that my online activity, both in school and outside school, will not cause my school, the staff, students or others distress or bring into disrepute.

- I will support the school approach to online safety and not deliberately upload or add any images, video, sounds or text that could upset or offend any member of the school community.
- I will respect the privacy and ownership of others' work on-line at all times (I will follow copyright law).
- I will not attempt to bypass the internet filtering system or computer management software.
- I understand that all my use of the Internet and other related technologies is monitored and logged and can be made available to my teachers.
- I understand that the use of the school's equipment and internet connection is a privilege that may be withdrawn if I abuse that privilege.
- I understand that these rules are designed to keep me safe and that if they are not followed, school sanctions will be applied, and my parent/carer may be contacted.
